## **A Chronology of Christ's Return**

## *Preceding the Day of the Lord:*

- 1. Jesus Christ came to earth, died, and rose again to reign in Heaven (1 Tim. 6:14-15).
- 2. There will be a falling away (2 Thess. 2:3). (History shows us that this has taken place.)



- 3. There will be no signs to usher in the Day of the Lord (Matt. 24:37-39; 1 Thess. 5:2-3; 2 Pet. 3:10).
- 4. Judgment will come when God's long-suffering is full (2 Pet. 3:9).

## *The Day of the Lord:*

- 1. The Lord will descend from heaven (1 Thess. 4:16).
- 2. Christ will descend with an accompanying shout, the voice of the archangel, and the trump of God (1 Thess. 4:16).
- 3. Christ will descend with angels in flaming fire (2 Thess. 1:7).
- 4. This will be a universal revelation of Jesus (1 Thess. 4:17).
- 5. The dead in Christ shall rise first in immortal bodies (1 Thess. 4:16; 1 Cor. 15:52).
- 6. Hades shall give up all the dead for the final judgment at the sound of Christ's voice (John 5:28-29).
- 7. All people will be changed into incorruptible bodies (1 Cor. 15:52-54).
- 8. Righteous living on earth will be caught up to Christ (1 Thess. 4:17; Matt. 24:40-41).
- 9. Christ will not set foot upon the earth (1 Thess. 4:17).
- 10. This world will pass away, being destroyed by fire (2 Pet. 3:10-11).
- 11. These events will happen in a "twinkling of an eye" (1 Cor. 15:52).
- 12. All men will be gathered to the judgment bar of Christ (John 5:29-30; Acts 24:25; 2 Cor.

- 5:10; 1 Pet. 4:5).
- 13. Every knee will bow and every tongue will confess Christ is Lord: (Phil. 2:10-11)
- 14. Christ will separate the sheep from the goats (Matt. 25:31-46).
- 15. All people will be judged by one standard, the Bible (John 12:48; Rev. 20:12).
- 16. All people will be judged according to deeds/ works (Rev. 20:12-13; 2 Cor. 5:10).
- 17. All people will be judged as to whether their works were authorized by Christ (Matt. 7:22-23).
- 18. Those who are covered by the blood of Christ will be passed over and avoid God's wrath (1 Cor. 5:7; 1 Pet. 1:17-18).
- 19. The redeemed will receive a crown (2 Tim. 4:8; Rev. 2:10).
- 20. Those who did not know God or did not obey Him will receive a sentence of punishment (2 Thess. 1:8-9).
